

# ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1994 - Section 152

## Application notice – Denison Trough / Mahalo tenures

### Resource activity: Site-Specific Petroleum Activity

It is advised that Santos QNT Pty Ltd and Australia Pacific LNG Pty Limited have lodged an application to amend environmental authority (EA) EPPG00872113 in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1994. The application relates to Authority to Prospect (ATP) 1191 and Petroleum Leases (PL) 450, 451, 457 and 1012 spanning roughly between Injune and Rolleston in non-contiguous blocks of tenure covering an area of approximately 280,518 ha in the Maranoa Regional Council and Central Highlands Council areas.

The amendment application seeks the alignment of the authorised petroleum activity conditions with other Santos EAs and to authorise stimulation activities.
