

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1994 - Section 233

Application notice - Petroleum Facility Licence (PFL) 10

Resource Activity: Site-Specific Petroleum Activity

It is advised that Santos GLNG Pty Ltd, TOTAL GLNG Australia, PAPT (Downstream) Pty Limited and KGLNG Liquefaction Pty Ltd have lodged an application to amend environmental authority EPPG00712213 (EA) in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1994 (Qld). The application relates to PFL 10, being the GLNG LNG Facility at Lot 1 on SP 235007, Lot 7 on SP 39683, Lot 1 on SP 228184, Lot 4 on SP 235936 and a portion of Lot 4 SP 235007 which covers an area of approximately 378 ha, and is located within the Curtis Island Industry Precinct of the Gladstone State Development Area.

The application seeks to amend Schedule B – Air emissions of the EA to include clear limits on the production of visible smoke from flaring during planned and unplanned plant maintenance (start-up/shutdown), plant upsets and plant emergencies. The proposed amendment seeks to establish a common standard for visible smoke from flaring at like LNG facilities in the region, ensuring consistency in regulation and community expectations.
