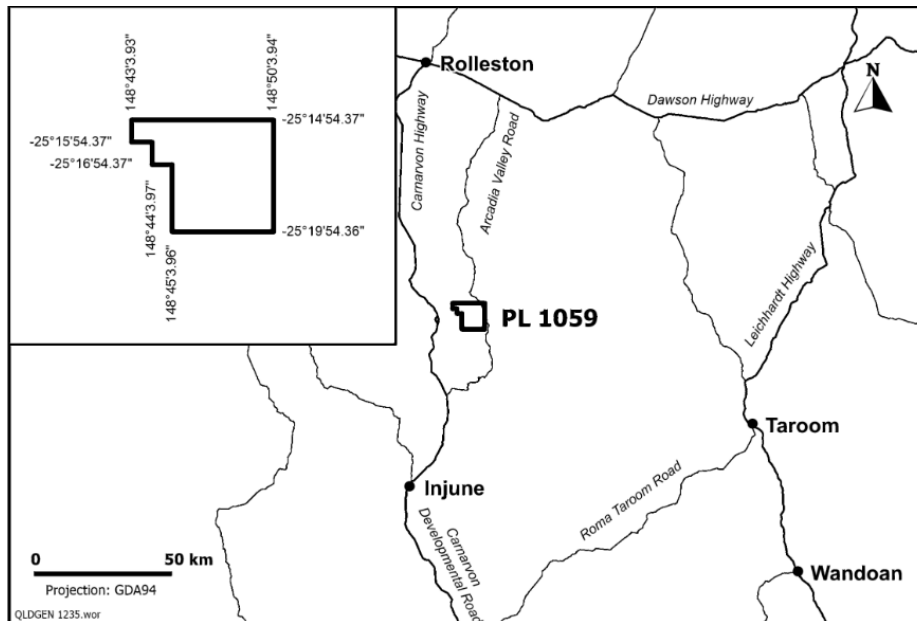


ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1994 - Section 152
Application notice – Towrie Petroleum Licence (PL) 1059

Resource Activity: Site-Specific Petroleum Activity

It is advised that Santos CSG Pty Ltd, Australia Pacific LNG (CSG) Pty Limited, PAPL (Upstream) Pty Limited, Total E&P Australia III and KGLNG E&P Pty Ltd have lodged an application for an environmental authority in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* (Qld). The application relates to 8,695ha of land on 1TR50, 11CP864585, 12CP864585, 15TR44, 2SP200046, 2TR13, 3TR12, 4SP283873, 8TR15 and 9TR17 located in the Surat / Bowen Basins of Eastern Queensland, approximately 60 kilometres north-east of Injune within the Central Highlands and Maranoa Regional local government areas.



The resource activity is proposed to occur on Petroleum Lease (PL) 1059 and will involve petroleum exploration and production activities including the construction and operation of coal seam gas wells, pipelines and ancillary infrastructure.
