For: Legbar 1 Gas Flowline (PPL 2064)—Santos QNT Pty Ltd proposes to construct and operate 5.5 kilometres of buried gas flowline from the Legbar 1 petroleum well to the Bantam 1 petroleum well on PPL 2064. The proposed activities will have a total area of surface impact of 8.5 hectares. Construction will occur over an approximate six-month period, with operation continuing for up to approximately 20 years.
