#### Our Commitment

A safe, diverse, and inclusive work environment is critical to achieving our Purpose and Vision 2040. Aligned to our strategic imperatives and Santos values and underpins our Employee Value Proposition, Real Thrives Here.

We are committed to embracing a diverse workforce. Diversity refers to the visible and invisible characteristics that make each of our people unique. We define diversity as the differences we bring to work. It includes diversity of thinking, diversity of background - such as gender, cultural background/identity, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, age, religious beliefs, education, professional discipline, industry experience.

We are committed to an inclusive work environment where everyone feels respected, trusted, valued, and psychologically safe to fully contribute the diversity of their unique abilities, qualities, skills, and perspectives.

We will not discriminate based on cultural background and identity, physical features, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, lawful sexual activity, age, disability, marital status, family responsibilities, pregnancy, carer responsibilities, religion, political opinion, national extraction, or social origin.
