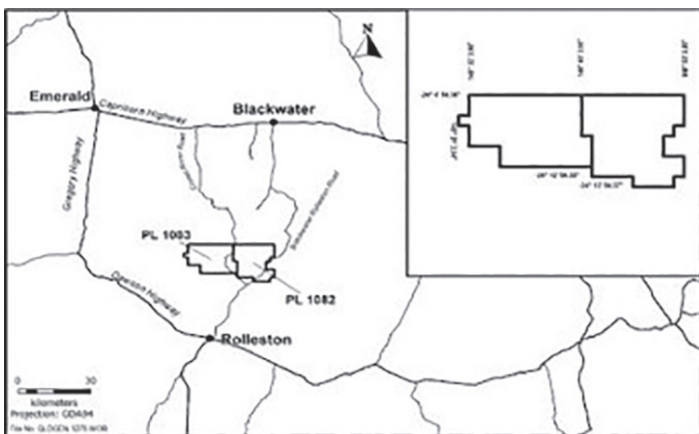


Application notice

Mahalo Gas Project**Resource activity: Site specific petroleum and gas activity**

It is advised that SANTOS QNT PTY. LTD (ACN 083 077 196) and COMET RIDGE MAHALO PTY LTD (ACN 149 902 456) have lodged an application for a major amendment to an environmental authority in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1994. The environmental authority being amended is P-EA-100178150.

The application relates to the Mahalo Gas Project located within the Central Highlands Regional Council (CHRC), approximately 40km north of Rolleston in Central QLD. The Mahalo Gas Project is a joint venture between Santos QNT Pty Ltd and Comet Ridge Mahalo Pty Ltd. The project comprises two petroleum leases (PL1082 and PL1083), over a combined area of approximately 470km².



The resource activity is proposed to occur on PL1082 and PL1083 and will involve:

- A gas compression facility.
- Regulated structures – produced water and brine storage dams.
- Accommodation camp.
- Disposal of residual drilling material.
- Additional Environmentally relevant activities (ERAs):
 - Ancillary 15 – Fuel burning.
 - Ancillary 55 2(c) – Other waste reprocessing or treatment.
 - Ancillary 62 1(c) – Resource recovery and transfer facility operation.
 - Ancillary 63 1(b-i) – Sewage treatment.

The application documents for the project consist of a cover letter, site-specific environmental authority amendment application form, supporting information report and request for further information response.
